

Mission Trip Participant Role Description.

Pipeline: Participant

Reports to: Mission Trip Team Leader

Vision: Engage in God's mission (Rev. 7:9) through mission trips that impact the field and RHC.

Commitment: 1 mission trip - 4 to 10 days, depending on trip

Goals:

Impacts the Field

- encourage the mission partner
- move the mission forward
 - o serve the mission partner and their ministry in tangible ways
 - provide life-changing opportunities for locals through participants taking steps of faith to share Jesus

Impacts RHC

- transformed lives
 - o develop in participants a deeper heart like God's for the nations
 - provide life-changing experience for participants through God working in/through them
- move the mission forward
 - display and declare Jesus in local sphere of influence
 - o impact others through sharing about the experience
 - build a deeper connection between the mission partner and RHC

Responsibilities

- 1. Preparation (acceptance to departure)
 - a) Complete action steps given by team leader or Global Missions Coach to prepare for trip
 - b) Submit payments or raise financial support by set deadlines
 - c) Complete all trip competencies
 - d) Attend and participate in team huddles
 - e) Pray! (especially for a heart that is humble, flexible and compassionate)
- 2. On-location (departure to return)
 - a) Serve mission partner and ministry
 - b) Encourage mission partner and build relationship
 - c) Step out in faith, and walk in the power of the Holy Spirit
 - d) Serve and love teammates
 - e) Honor the Lord by respectfully following the trip leadership. Commit to lovingly confronting them, if you encounter an area of disagreement.
 - f) Complete action steps given by team leader or mission partner
- 3. Return and Share (return to on-going)
 - a) Complete action steps given by team leader or GM Coach to share about your experience
 - b) Attend and participate in post-trip sharing and possible team huddle to debrief further
