

# Monday

"I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him" (Ephesians 1:16–17)

- Bless God, the Father, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessings in the heavenly places.
- Confess and repent of any sin in your life. If you have never confessed Jesus as Lord (that Jesus is sole authority you will obey), today is the day to make that decision. Do not delay. Inform someone at Redemption Hill. We want to help you as you start out on this exciting journey with Jesus.
- Thank God for the fellowship of our brothers and sisters at Redemption Hill.
- \*Ask the Lord to give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation to know Him more. Ask the Lord to use you and our entire congregation to spread the knowledge of Him starting from our various neighborhoods and to the ends of the earth.
- \*Pray for our church family as we prioritize our 2021 Vision to invest at least 1% of our day (15 minutes) in focused, face to face time with God. Pray that we would hear from God and that He would change us as we read through the Bible Reading Plan.

# Tuesday

"...having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places..." (Ephesians 1:18–20)

- Praise God for the immeasurable greatness of His power.
- Confess and turn away from any sin in your life. Take practical steps to run away from anything or thought that looks evil.
- \*Thank God for the great progress (loosening restrictions) our nation is making in winning the battle against COVID-19.
- \*Pray for nations like India and Brazil where COVID-19 is currently overwhelming the healthcare system. Pray wisdom for our leaders at RHC so that we will continue to safely navigate reopening.
- \*Ask the Lord to open your eyes that you may know the hope to which He has called us the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints and the immeasurable greatness of His power towards us who believe.

# Wednesday

"...that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith-that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God". (Ephesians 3:16–19)

- Praise the God who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think.
- Confess all known sins and ask the Holy Spirit to help you fight sin in your life.
- Thank God for His mercy that saved you in bringing you out of darkness into the kingdom of light.
- \* Ask the Father to strengthen you with power through His Holy Spirit in your inner being. Pray the power of the Holy Spirit to fill every RHC member.
- \*Ask the Lord for strength to comprehend the boundless breadth, length, height and depth of His love for us.

### Thursday

"I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."

(Ephesians 4:1–3)

- Praise God for His great love and compassion for mankind.
- Confess all known sins and pray for grace to walk continually along the paths of righteousness.
- Thank God for the power of His Holy Spirit that helps us to walk in a manner worthy of our calling in the Lord.
- Pray that all of us at RHC will continue to grow in humility, patience, and love for one another.
- \*Ask the Lord to help us so that we will be eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

### Friday

"Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God." (Ephesians 5:1–2)

- Praise God for the great love which He lavished on us that we would be called His children.
- Confess all known sins and ask the Holy Spirit to help you fight sin in your life.
- Thank God for the gift of community and fellowship that exists among brothers and sisters at RHC.
- Pray that we all will continue to walk in love: that we will love each other more and more.
- Pray that God will give us a heart of love and compassion for unbelievers that will cause us to relentlessly pursue them with God's sacrificial love and share the gospel with them.
