

Monday

- "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." (Lamentations 3:22–23)
- Praise God for His unending steadfast love and mercies that saved you.
- Confess and repent of the sin of ungratefulness.
- Reflect upon and count the blessings in your life; and thank God for them, one by one.
- *Ask the Lord to give you and our RHC family a heart that honors God and gives thanks to Him.
- *Ask the Holy Spirit to help our church family experience fullness of joy and peace as we spend face-to-face time with Him.

Tuesday

"I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship." (Romans 12:1)

- * Praise God for His mercies that saved you from the wrath to come when Jesus returns to judge the world.
- Confess and repent of any sin in your life. If you have never confessed Jesus as Lord (that Jesus is sole authority you will obey), today is the day to make that decision. Do not delay. Inform someone at Redemption Hill. We want to help you as you start out on this exciting journey with Jesus.
- The masks are off!!! Thank God for the great progress we have made in winning the battle against COVID-19. Pray that our leaders will continue to walk in wisdom so that we can continue to improve on this progress.
- *Ask the Holy Spirit to help you surrender your life as a living sacrifice that is holy and acceptable to God.
- *Ask the Lord to use you and RHC as agents of His mercies to meet needs around Medford and the greater Boston area.

Wednesday

- "...Which of these three, do you think, proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell among the robbers?" He said, "The one who showed him mercy." And Jesus said to him, "You go, and do likewise." (Luke 10:36–37)
- Praise God for how He carries your burdens and for all the benefits He gives you everyday.
- Repent and ask the Lord to forgive the many times when you haven't shown mercy to others as you have received mercy.
- *Ask the Lord to give you a compassionate and merciful heart so that you can respond to the needs around you.
- *Ask the Lord to help you and our church to respond and act generously, with mercy and compassion, to the identified needs in our community: food insecurity, foster care and addiction recovery.

Thursday

"You have said, "Seek my face." My heart says to you, "Your face, Lord, do I seek". (Psalm 27:8)

- * Praise God for His invisible attributes, namely, His eternal power and divine nature which are clearly perceived in the things He has made.
- Repent of the sin of not seeking and loving God with all your heart as He commanded us.
- Thank God for the invitation and the great privilege to be able to enter God's presence with confidence and without fear.
- Pray for the grace for all RHC to seek God with all our hearts. Pray for an undivided heart to seek God as the greatest treasure of our lives.
- Pray for our church family as we prioritize our 2021 Vision to invest at least 1% of our day (15 minutes) in focused, face to face time with God. Pray that we would hear from God and that He would change us as we read through the Bible Reading Plan.

Friday

"So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise". (John 5:19)

- * Praise God for the great privilege we have in Christ to be able to partner with God in His work of redemption.
- Confess all known sins and ask the Holy Spirit to help you fight sin in your life.
- Thank God for the light of the gospel which He shone in your heart to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
- *Ask God to help you see as He sees. Ask the Lord to show you where He is working so that you can partner with Him.
- *Ask God to remove the veil that covers the eyes of the unbelievers in your life: family, neighbors, co-workers. Mention specific names.
- * Ask God for boldness to share the gospel with these unbelievers you have just prayed for.
